Travel Update

December 1, 2021

The government of Canada has placed a ban on travellers arriving from ten countries: Nigeria, Malawi, Egypt, South Africa, Mozambique, Namibia, Zimbabwe, Botswana, Lesotho and Eswatini. This is part of the process around questions regarding the Omicron strain of the Covid virus.

We do not know how long travel restrictions will be in place but are hopeful that changes in health and pandemic medicine will help governments respond in an effective time frame.

If you have booked a flight for a student to travel to Canada, we recommend the following:

1. Keep in contact with your airline and travel representative.
