Updates from Immigration Canada re: entry to Canada

Please note that with immediate effect, the Government of Canada has changed the entry requirements for those wishing to enter Canada.

- For international students (one who enters Canada to study and live in Canada while they study at an <u>approved designated learning institution</u>) and who are <u>under 18</u> years of age, the requirements remain essentially the same.
- However, students who are 18 years of age or older when they travel must <u>qualify as</u> a fully vaccinated traveller to enter Canada.
- > Accompanying adults must also qualify as fully vaccinated travellers.

We recognize that this may affect some travel plans. We strongly urge all students and parents who are planning to travel to Canada to obtain full information at the following websites:
