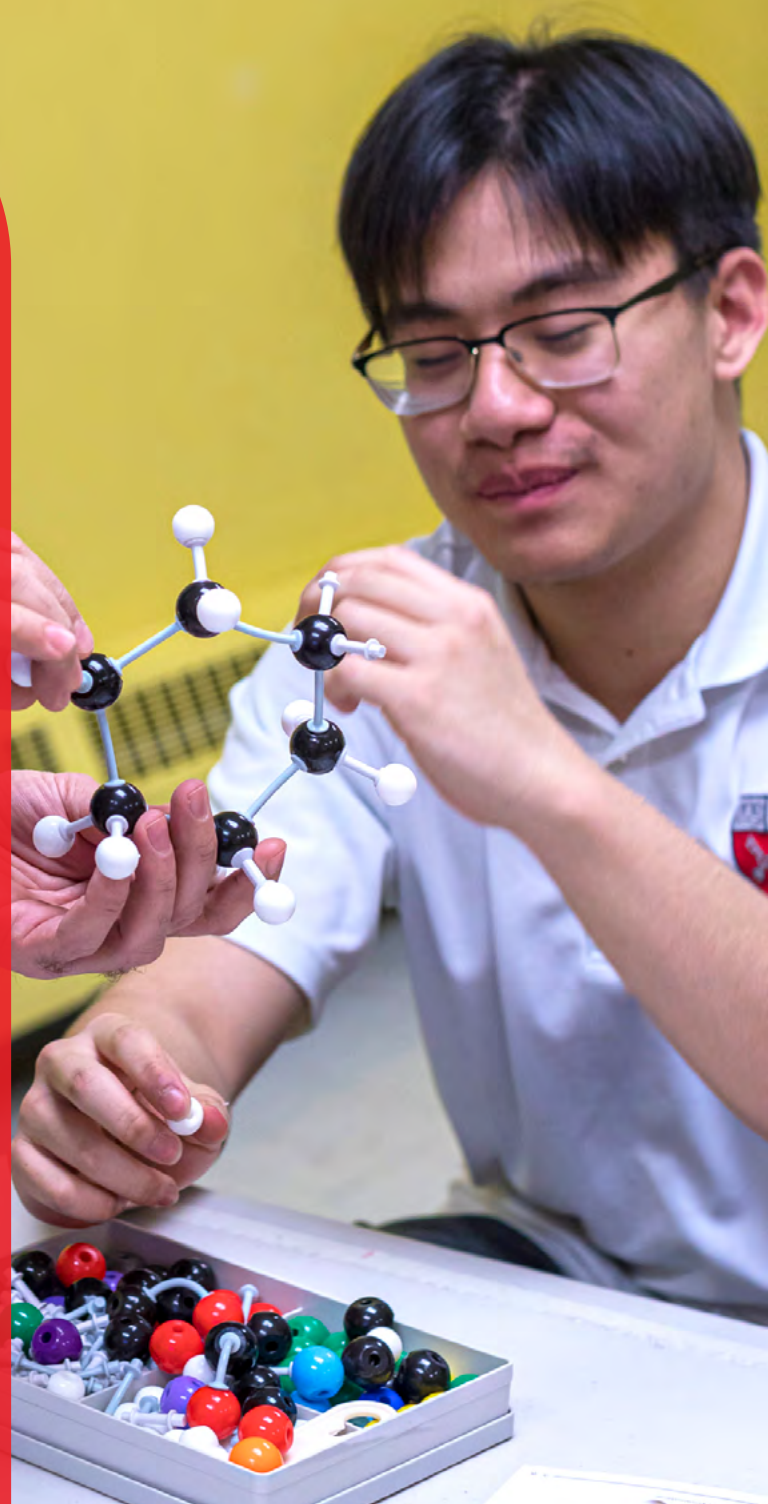

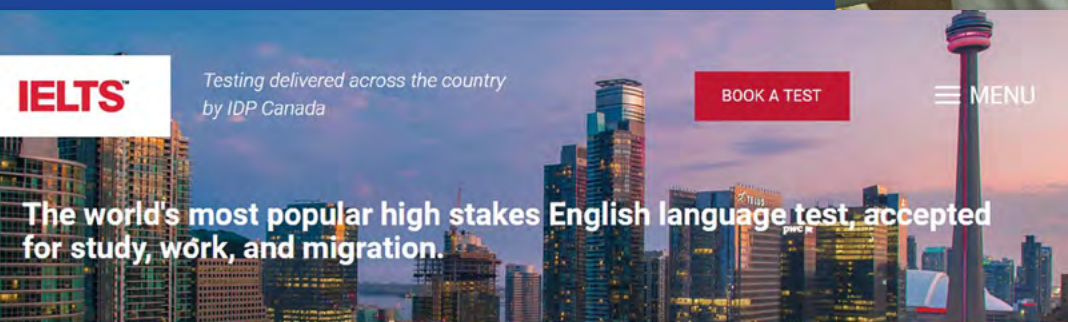
SOC offers English as a Second Language (ESL) courses at 5 levels for international students who need to improve their English language skills.

Our Programs

Grades 9-12 Diploma Program

Highlights: Upon graduation, students receive the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) granted by the Ministry of Education of the province of Ontario.

Eligibility: Applicants must submit transcripts showing completion of education equivalent to at least Grade 8 or 9, detailing courses and credits for OSSD readiness.

Online & blended programs are also available.

Intake: Every April, August, and December

Pre-University Program

Highlights: Pre-U program is your link to university in Canada. The duration of the program at SOC will be determined by the number of equivalent credits granted by the Ministry of Education.

Eligibility: Grade 11 or 12 equivalent, detailing courses passed and credits accumulated for OSSD curriculum readiness.

Online & blended programs are also available.

Intake: Every April, August, December

English as a Second Language (ESL) Program

Highlights: Students can study ESL for academic, general, or business purposes. Class sizes are small, ensuring the optimum environment for correction and practice.

Eligibility: Open to local & international learners with varying English proficiency levels.

Intake: Enrolment is on-going throughout the calendar year.

Summer/Winter Camp Program

Highlights: The SOC Summer/Winter Camp Programs provide international students with an immersion forum for practising and acquiring language while providing participants with opportunities for entertainment and exploration.

Eligibility: Elementary, Middle School, Highschool.

Intake: Year round.



Our Curriculum

Students who successfully complete our program are awarded the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) which is the Ministry of Education’s certificate for completion of the high school curriculum in the province of Ontario. It reflects the standards and requirements of the publicly funded province-wide school system.

Courses Required for Majors in Business, Science and Engineering, and Arts

Business

(Finance/Management/Accounting)



English, Advanced Functions, Calculus, Data Management, Economics, International Business, Business Leaderships, Marketing, Canadian & International Law, etc.

Requirements: English and 1 or 2 Mathematics courses are compulsory; 3 to 4 courses are elective courses.

Science & Engineering

(Computer/Engineering/Medicine)



English, Advanced Functions, Calculus, Data Management, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, etc.

Requirements: English, Advanced Functions, Calculus, Physics and/ or Chemistry are compulsory; 1 to 2 other courses are elective courses.

Arts

(Social Sciences/ Humanities/ Arts)



English, Advanced Functions, Calculus, Data Management, Individual & Families, Canadian History, Geography, International Languages.

Requirements: English and Advanced Functions are compulsory; 4 other courses are elective courses

School Location

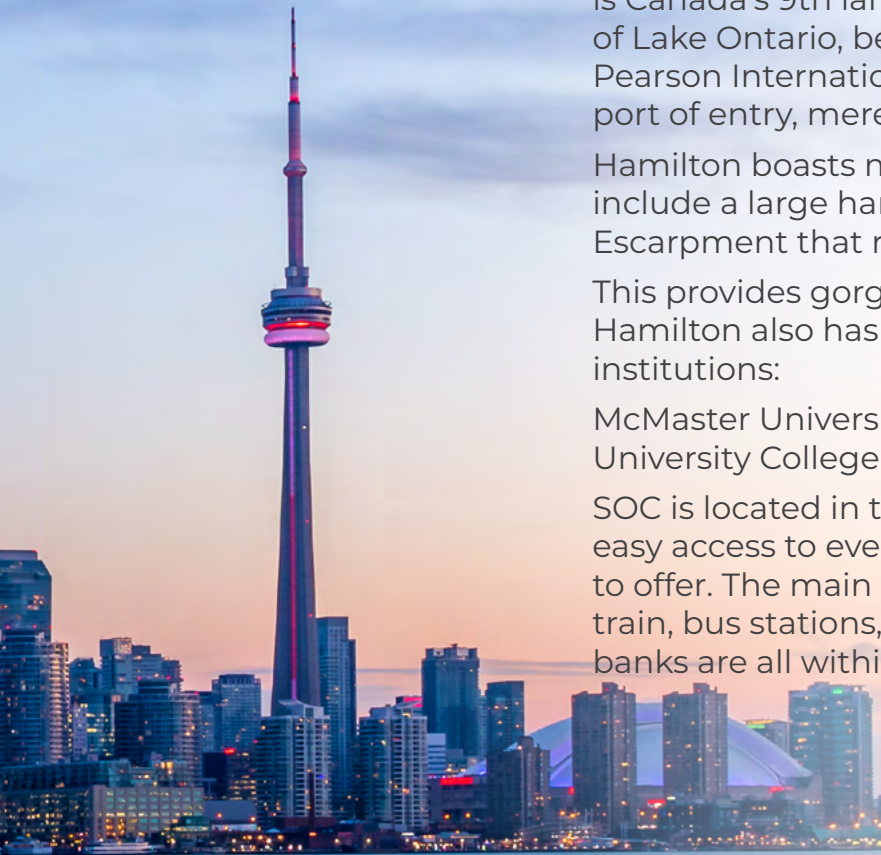
With a population of over 550,000 inhabitants, Hamilton is Canada's 9th largest city. It is situated on the shores of Lake Ontario, between Niagara Falls and Toronto. Pearson International Airport is a major international port of entry, merely an hour's drive away.

Hamilton boasts many geographic features which include a large harbour, lakefront and the Niagara Escarpment that runs through an urban landscape.

This provides gorgeous views and many waterfalls. Hamilton also has three renowned post-secondary institutions:

McMaster University, Mohawk College, and Redeemer University College.

SOC is located in the downtown core of Hamilton with easy access to everything that Hamilton City Centre has to offer. The main city library, financial district, central train, bus stations, downtown mall, supermarkets, and banks are all within a 10-minute walk of the school.
